

CITY OF KEWAUNEE RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE COLLECTION POLICY

In order for Kewaunee residential garbage to be collected by the City's contracted refuse hauler on a resident's designated day of pickup, the guidelines below must be followed:

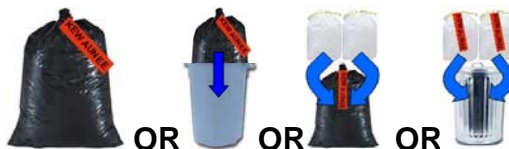
- Garbage must be placed in sealed or tied plastic bags that are no larger than 33-gallons in size.
- An orange "KEWAUNEE" sticker must be affixed to the outside of each bag by wrapping the sticker around the neck of the bag.
- Each bag of garbage must not exceed 50 pounds in weight.
- If one has problems with birds or other animals getting into their garbage, one may place their plastic garbage bag, with sticker affixed to it, into a metal or plastic garbage container no larger than 33-gallons in size. A cover on the container is not required while set out at curbside for collection. **DO NOT PUT A STICKER ON THE CONTAINER; ONE STICKER MUST BE AFFIXED TO EACH PLASTIC BAG.**
- Kitchen garbage bags (typically 11 to 13 gallons in size) may be placed inside of a larger plastic bag not exceeding 33-gallons in size and when sealed or tied, only one garbage sticker would be required.
- Multiple garbage bags placed into a container that does not comply with the above guideline **MUST HAVE A STICKER AFFIXED TO EACH BAG, REGARDLESS OF THE BAG SIZE.**
- There is no limit to the amount of refuse you place at the curb, as long as it is properly prepared and an orange "KEWAUNEE" sticker is properly attached to each bag.
- Garbage may be placed at the curb for collection no sooner than 24 hours prior to the scheduled collection date, but no later than 6 a.m. of the day of collection to insure it will be picked up by the hauler.

Failure to comply with the above guidelines will result in the issuance of a violation warning ticket by the refuse hauler and your garbage not being picked up.

CITY OF KEWAUNEE RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE RECYCLING POLICY

Curbside recycling for residents is collected on the same day as your scheduled residential garbage pickup. Recyclables may be placed at the curb no sooner than 24 hours prior to the scheduled collection date, but no later than 6:00 a.m. of the day of collection to ensure it will be picked up by the hauler.

It is preferred that you use a blue recycling container available for purchase at City Hall. If you do not have a recycling container, you can use a Rubbermaid type tote or old clothes basket. A metal or plastic garbage container may be used but do not fill more than half full. The City's hauler conducts comingled recycling, meaning that glass, metal, and plastic can be placed in one container and does not have to be separated. The chart below shows what items are acceptable for recycling and what items are not.

BATTERIES 	AUTO BATTERIES - RETURN TO RETAILERS. RECHARGEABLE & CELL PHONE BATTERIES, DROP OFF AT KEWAUNEE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 401 FIFTH STREET (FREE DISPOSAL).
MOTOR OIL 	PLACE IN OIL CONTAINER AT PUBLIC WORKS SHOP, 207 FIRST STREET. DO NOT MIX SOLVENTS OR OTHER MATERIAL WITH OIL.
FLUORESCENT LIGHT TUBES 	DROP OFF AT KEWAUNEE MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 401 FIFTH STREET (\$ CHARGE/EACH TUBE). DROP OFF COMPACT FLOURESCENT LIGHTS (CFL) AT KEWAUNEE MUNICIPAL BUILDING OR WALTER'S HOW-TO-STORE, E4351 COUNTY RD K, ALGOMA (NO CHARGE FOR DISPOSAL).

Residents living on Center Street and North (Tuesdays).

Garbage and Recycling Collection will be one day later due to a holiday. This will occur in June, July and September 2011.

Residents living South of Center Street (Wednesdays).

Large/Big Item Collection (2nd Monday of the Month) - city wide pickup. Two orange garbage stickers for up to 3 cubic yards. Special cost for refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, televisions, computers. Contact City Hall at 388-5000 for pricing and arrange for obtaining special green sticker. Place no sooner than 24 hours prior to scheduled collection day.

Brush Collection (4th Monday of the Month) - city wide pickup. Place butt end to curb. Tree limbs are to be whole. Place no sooner than 24 hours prior to scheduled collection day.

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS: LEAF COLLECTION - Tree leaves may be raked to street gutters only after October 15th.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION - Spring Clean-up Day(s) in April and/or May with dates to be published.

GARDEN WASTE COLLECTION - Fall Clean-up Day in October with date to be published.

OTHER MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Yard Waste: In addition to the scheduled Spring Clean Up Days, residents can dispose of their yard waste by taking it to the City Composite Site located on Lakeshore Drive north of Duvall Street. Acceptable yard waste that can be disposed of at the composite site includes leaves, grass clippings, yard and garden debris. This term does not include stumps, brush, roots or shrubs with intact root balls. On Spring Clean Up Days, yard waste shall be placed in bags or containers and remain open and not tied shut.

Large/Big Items: All waste building materials set out for curbside collection shall be placed in containers or be properly prepared so that it can be reasonably handled and loaded by one person into the collection vehicle and each individual item shall weigh no more than 50 pounds, with the exception of large appliances. Waste from large remodeling projects will not be picked up for collection. All waste materials shall not have sharp edges, nails or other objects that would be hazardous to the collection person. To assist the collection person, separate metal items from non-metal items. No concrete will be picked up.

Open Burning: Open burning of fuel, garbage, or other combustible refuse or waste material, including leaves, brush, tree trimmings and grass is prohibited. Exemptions exist for recreational fires for cooking, warming or ceremonial purposes. Only wood may be burned. Also exempt is a cooking fire contained in a charcoal grill, campstove or other device designed for the purpose of cooking or smoking using charcoal or a non-ash producing fuel when used for food preparation.
