D. Kickbusch moved and Jeske seconded to approve the Special Council Meeting minutes of November 14, 2012. Motion carried unanimously.

Under public comment, John Gallenberger inquired on the status of Whoopies demo. Jason Jelinek informed the Council of a private group looking at wanting to restore the old Svoboda Industries grandfather clock and relocate it on city property. Tony Jeanquart commented on low water levels and dredging occurring in the area.
