

**OFFICIAL MINUTES
OF THE
CITY OF KEWAUNEE COMMON COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
JUNE 9, 2014**

Mayor Blaha called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. whereas the Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by prayer and meditation.

The Council received the Finance Committee minutes of May 12, 2014.

D. Kickbusch moved and Griffith seconded to approve the issuance of Operator's Licenses as submitted. Motion carried unanimously.

D. Kickbusch moved and Gilbertson seconded to approve the issuance of annual license renewals as submitted for "Class B", "Class A", Class "A", Class "B", Soda/Water, Cigarettes, and Miscellaneous. Motion carried with Kunkel abstaining.

D. Kickbusch moved and Dworak seconded to approve the May 2014 Accounts Payables in the amount of \$186,568.29. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

The Council received the Public Works Committee minutes of May 27, 2014.

Vollenweider moved and Kunkel seconded to advertise the sale of 1987 Bucket Truck with a minimum bid beginning at \$4,000. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Vollenweider moved and D. Kickbusch seconded to award the 2014 Sidewalk and Curb Proposal Work to Badgerland Concrete. Motion carried unanimously.

The Council received the Beautification Committee minutes of May 20, 2014.

Jirtle moved and Vollenweider seconded to approve the May 12, 2014 Regular Council Meeting minutes as submitted. Motion carried unanimously.

Under public comment, Police Chief Salentine introduced to the Council new Police Officer Brian Gale.

Upon the recommendation of the City Engineers, Ayres Associates, Kunkel moved and Christman seconded to award the Former Klockner Facility Site Demolition Project Bid to Badgerland Demolition & Earthwork, DePere, Wisconsin in the amount of \$373,418.57. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Tom Kleiman discussed with the Council a proposed KCEDC consulting proposal with Arrowhead Strategies for the purpose of acquiring funding for harbor projects at the State Legislative level. Further discussion of this proposal will occur at a Special Council Meeting on Monday, June 16, 2014 at 6:30 p.m.

Christman moved and Kunkel seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:04 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
