

Effective the week of October 9, 2017, garbage and recycling will now be picked up in the 96 gallon totes supplied by Advance Disposal. The wheeled carts with lids will provide you with more room for more items, and help keep your neighborhood clean and green.

CITY OF KEWAUNEE RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE COLLECTION POLICY

Starting the week of October 9, 2017, your service day for garbage will be **EVERY THURSDAY**. Your first automated garbage service will be on Thursday, October 12th.

Cart Placement:

- Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from the curb.
- There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your carts and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.
- Cart handles should be facing the house and away from the street.
- **Totes must be placed curbside the night before collection day, or prior to 6 a.m. on the day of collection.**
- All items must be placed in the cart in order to be collected.
- Items NOT accepted for pickup include:
 - NO Hazardous waste
 - NO Electronics
 - NO Tires
 - NO White Goods
 - No Construction Debris

Starting the week of October 16, 2017, your service day for recycling will be **EVERY OTHER THURSDAY**. Your first automated recycling service will be on Thursday, October 19th.

Cart Placement:

- Carts should be placed no more than three (3) feet from the curb.
- There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your carts and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes and other carts.
- Cart handles should be facing the house and away from the street.
- **Totes must be placed curbside the night before collection day, or prior to 6 a.m. on the day of collection.**
- All items must be placed in the cart in order to be collected.
- Items NOT accepted for pickup include:
 - NO Hazardous waste
 - NO Electronics
 - NO Tires
 - NO White Goods
 - No Construction Debris

OTHER MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Yard Waste: In addition to the scheduled Spring/Fall Clean Up Days, residents can dispose of their yard waste by taking it to the City Composite Site located on Lakeshore Drive north of Duvall Street. Acceptable yard waste that can be disposed of at the composite site includes leaves, grass clippings, yard and garden debris. This term does not include stumps, brush, roots or shrubs with intact root balls. On Spring/Fall Clean Up Days, yard waste shall be placed in bags or containers and remain open and not tied shut.

Large Items: All waste building materials set out for curbside collection shall be properly prepared so that it can be reasonably handled and loaded by one person into the collection vehicle and each individual item shall weigh no more than 50 pounds, with the exception of large appliances. Waste from large remodeling projects will not be picked up for collection. All waste materials shall not have sharp edges, nails or other objects that would be hazardous to the collection person. To assist the collection person, separate metal items from non-metal items. No concrete will be picked up.

Open Burning: Open burning of fuel, garbage, or other combustible refuse or waste material, including leaves, brush, tree trimmings and grass is prohibited. Exemptions exist for recreational fires for cooking, warming or ceremonial purposes. Only wood may be burned. Also exempt is a cooking fire contained in a charcoal grill, campstove or other device designed for the purpose of cooking or smoking using charcoal or a non-ash producing fuel when used for food preparation. Most items will require two orange “KEWAUNEE” garbage sticker for every 3 cubic ft. Items listed below will require special stickers. These stickers can be purchased at City Hall, 401 Fifth St.
