FALL LEAF/GARDEN WASTE COLLECTION

The City Department of Public Works will begin its pickup of leaves the week of October 15th. Residents are asked to place their leaves in the street along the curb so they can be picked up. **Please do not place any sticks, brush, other woody material or garden waste in with the leaves.** Do not park on the leaf piles. Collection will continue through November 15th weather permitting.

In addition, the City of Kewaunee will conduct a Fall Garden Waste pick-up on Monday, October 15th and again Monday, November 5th. Citizens must place leaves, grass, and yard waste in **open containers** or **untied bags** at the curb ready for pick-up by 7:00 a.m.

After that time grass clippings, leaves, and garden waste must be taken to the City's compost site on Lakeshore Drive.

Questions on leaf pickup operations should be directed to City Hall at 388-5000.

Brush pickup will continue on the fourth Monday of the month through November, weather permitting.
