

**CITY OF KEWAUNEE
FALL LEAF/GARDEN WASTE COLLECTION**

The City Department of Public Works will begin its pickup of leaves week of October 2nd. Residents are asked to place their leaves in the street along the curb so they can be vacuumed. Please do not place any sticks, brush, or other woody material in with the leaves. Also do not park on the leaf piles. Collection will continue through November 17th weather permitting.

In addition, the City of Kewaunee will conduct a Fall Garden Waste pick-up on Monday, October 16th and Monday, November 6th. Citizens must place leaves, grass, and yard waste in open containers or untied bags at curb ready for pick-up by 7:00 a.m.

After that time grass clippings, leaves, and garden waste must be taken to the City's compost site on Lakeshore Drive.

Questions on leaf pickup operations should be directed to City Hall at 388-5000.

Brush pickup will continue on the fourth Monday of the month through November, weather permitting.
