2020 FALL LEAF/GARDEN WASTE COLLECTION

The City of Kewaunee Public Works Department will begin its leaf collection on October 12th. Residents are asked to place their leaves in the street along the curb so they can be picked up. **Please do not place any sticks, brush, other woody material, or garden waste in with the leaves.** Do not park on the leaf piles. Collection will continue through November 16th, weather permitting.

In addition, the City of Kewaunee will conduct a Fall Garden Waste pick-up on Monday, October 12th and November 2nd. Residents must place leaves, grass, and yard waste in **open containers** or **untied bags** at the curb ready for pick-up by 7:00 a.m.

After that time grass clippings, leaves, and garden waste must be taken to the City's compost site on Lakeshore Drive.

Brush pickup will continue on the fourth Monday of the month through November, weather permitting.
