

ORDINANCE NO. 570-15

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DEPOSIT OF SNOW
IN THE CITY OF KEWAUNEE

The Common Council of the City of Kewaunee, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 54-129 of the Municipal Code of Kewaunee, Wisconsin, is hereby created as follows:

"Sec. 54-129. DEPOSIT OF SNOW.

- (1) DEPOSIT ON STREETS PROHIBITED. No person shall throw or put, or cause to be thrown or put, any snow or ice into any street, avenue, or other public place in the City. The term "street" for purposes of this ordinance shall not include the tree lawn in residential districts.
- (2) DEPOSIT ON CITY OWNED PROPERTY. Absent written permission from the Director of Public Works, no person shall throw or put, or cause to be thrown or put, any snow or ice onto any property owned by the City except tree lawns in residential districts.
- (3) FIRE HYDRANTS. No person shall move, plow, blow, shovel, deposit or place any snow within two (2) feet of any City fire hydrant.
- (4) EXCEPTION FOR SNOW FROM ALLEYS AND SIDEWALKS IN THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESS DISTRICT AREA. Notwithstanding the general prohibition set forth in sec. 54-129(1), snow from alleys and sidewalks in the downtown business district area which sidewalks do not abut a tree lawn, may be plowed, shoveled or blown into the right-of-way of the abutting street. The downtown business district area is defined as the area bounded by Harrison Street, Dodge Street, and Kilbourn Street.
- (5) EXCEPTION FOR SNOW FROM ALLEYS IN SINGLE-FAMILY OR TWO-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS. Notwithstanding the general prohibition set forth in sec. 54-129(1), snow from public alleys in singlefamily or two-family residential districts, and in the downtown business district area, may be plowed, shoveled or blown into the right-of-way of the abutting street in an area and in a manner as designated by the Director of Public Works. The downtown business district area is defined as the area bounded by Harrison Street, Dodge Street, and Kilbourn Street.
- (6) EXCEPTION FOR SNOW FROM PARKING AREAS IN THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESS DISTRICT AREA. Notwithstanding the general prohibition set forth in sec. 54-129(1), snow from parking areas in the downtown business district area, which parking areas do not have

sufficient space as determined by the Director of Public Works to allow the plowed snow to be stacked on a portion of the parking area or on abutting property owned by the owner of the parking area, may be plowed, shoveled or blown into the right-of-way of the abutting street. The downtown business district area is defined as the area bounded by Harrison Street, Dodge Street, and Kilbourn Street.”

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.


