

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 62 OF THE  
MUNICIPAL CODE OF KEWAUNEE, WISCONSIN,  
ENTITLED "STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES"

The Common Council of the City of Kewaunee, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 62-5(a) entitled "Sidewalk construction and repair" of the Municipal Code of Kewaunee, Wisconsin, is repealed and recreated as follows:

- “(a) The provisions of Wis. Stats. § 66.0907, relating to the construction and repair of sidewalks, so far as applicable to the city, are hereby adopted by reference and shall apply, provided the initial cost of construction of a sidewalk shall be borne by the abutting property owner. It shall be the duty of the city on determination made by the Public Works Director, to repair or reconstruct any existing sidewalk within a residential district which directly abut single-family, duplex, or multi-family residences along or upon any public street, alley or highway in the city and to pay one-half (½) of the entire cost thereof, and the other one-half (½) to be paid by the abutting property owner. However, where such repairs or reconstruction are caused by the property owner's negligence or construction work done by or for the property owner, the entire cost shall be paid by the property owner. It shall be the duty of the abutting property owner in a B-1, B-2, B-3, I-1, I-2 and I-3 District to perpetually maintain the sidewalks at the owner's cost along or upon any street or alley in the city.”

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
