INSURANCE AND BOND REQUIREMENTS	
Kewaunee City Ordinance Chapter 14-116 requires the following: The applicant shall include with such application a surety bond in the sum of \$5,000.00, which bond shall indemnify the city from any costs and expenses which may accrue against the city as the result of granting such permit. No pennit to move or raze any building shall be granted until the applicant files a certicate of insurance naming the city as an additional insured with the city clerk-treasurer, giving evidence of liability insurance in the following amounts: Bodily injury: \$1,000,000.00 each occurrence, \$2,000,000.00 aggregate. Property damage: \$5,000,000.00 each occurrence, \$2,000,000.00 aggregate.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS
Except as provided below, a raze permit may be issued not less than 10 calendar days following the building inspector's receipt of a fully completed application, unless the chair of the commission, in writing, earlier notifies the chief building inspector or assistant building inspectgor of its non-interest in or completion of documentationof the property. A. The building inspector shall forward such completed application the the chair of the historic preservation commission for it to determine whether the structure subject to the raze pennit is listed on the national, state or local register of historic places or if the structure in included in a federal, state or local historic district as a contributing structure. The historic perservation commission may document such structure with in the ten calendar day period as permitted by property owner. B. If such structure is listed as on the local register of historic places or if such structure is listed as a contributing property in a local historic district under § 38-6 of this Code, the regulations of that chapter shall govern the issuance of any permit to raze the structure. C. This subsection shall not apply to structures for which an order has been issued for razing or rehabilitation in accordance with Wis. Stats. § 66.04 I3 or § 94-12 of this code.
