A RESOLUTION PROMOTING FAIR HOUSING

LET IT BE KNOWN TO ALL PERSONS of the City of Kewaunee that discrimination in the sale, lease, advertisement or financing of housing, or in the provision of real estate brokerage services, because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, handicap or familial status, is prohibited by Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Federal Fair Housing Law) and the Fair Housing Amendments Act of 1988. Furthermore, it is the policy of the City of Kewaunee to implement programs to ensure equal opportunity in housing for all persons regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, handicap or familial status. Therefore, the City of Kewaunee does hereby pass the following resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Kewaunee that within the available resources of the City of Kewaunee, all persons who feel that they have been discriminated against in any housing or real estate purchase, conveyance or transaction because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, handicap or familial status, will be assisted to seek equity under federal and state laws by filing a complaint with the Chicago Regional Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity office or the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Kewaunee shall publicize this resolution. Publicizing this resolution shall assist owners of real estate, builders, developers, and mortgage lenders in becoming more aware of their respective responsibilities and rights under Federal Fair Housing legislation, and all other applicable state or local laws or ordinances.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that publicizing this resolution and the City's applicable fair housing information shall bring attention and knowledge about equal opportunity in housing.
