

**OFFICIAL MINUTES
OF THE
SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY OF KEWAUNEE COMMON COUNCIL
DECEMBER 20, 2017**

Mayor Christman called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Purchase of a Used Squad for Police

Assistant police Chief Jim Kleiman talked about the current car they were bidding on. He also talked about the retrofit costs to make the car ready for the K-9.

Discussion was had about what would happen if they didn't get this car. Alderperson Dworak stated that the prior motion did not specify what type or model car was to be purchased. Plan B is to look for something comparable.

Alderperson Jelinek moved and Alderperson Kickbusch seconded the motion to spend \$22,000 (\$16,000 from contingencies and \$6,000 from K-9 Fund) for the purchase of a used squad car.

Alderperson Jelinek moved and Alderperson Kickbush seconded the amended motion to spend \$22,000 (\$10,000 from contingencies and \$12,000 from K-9 Fund) for the purchase of a used squad car. Motion carried unanimous except for Kuehl who abstained.

Alderperson Jelinek moved and Alderperson Kuehl seconded the amended motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:20 pm. Motion carried unanimously.
