REORGANIZATION BUSINESS:

Recognition of Don Kickbusch, Dian Jirtle and Bill Wolske

Mayor Christman thanked and present plaques to Don Kickbusch, for 16 years of service, Diane Jirtle, for 4 years of service as a council member and Bill Wolske for provide 40 years of legal service to the community.

Administer Oath of Office to Newly Elected Officials

City Clerk/Treasurer Decur Swore into Office, Mayor Christman, Alderperson Jackson, Alderperson Jelinek, Alderperson Stangel and Alderperson Zimmerman for a two-year term.

Election of Council President

Alderperson Griffith nominated Alderperson Kuehl for Council President, with no other nominees.

Alderperson Dworak moved and Alderperson Griffith seconded the motion to appoint Alderperson Kuehl as Council President. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of "Rules of Order" for Common Council Meeting

Alderperson Griffith ask for the approval of the Rules of Order be tabled and brought to the next Committee of the Whole for review of Rule Number three "Committees". Alderperson Schiller also had some concerns that should be addressed at the next Committee of the Whole regarding the time of meetings and the agenda approval process.

Alderperson Griffith moved, seconded by Alderperson Schiller the motion to table the Rules of Order for further discussion on the next Committee of the whole meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Ratification of Mayoral Appointments to Committees and Boards

Mayor Christman recommended the appointments of John Mastalir and Mike Bories to the Planning Commission for a Three year term, reappoint Helen Clinton, Don Rabas, Janice Gilbertson, and appoint Don Kickbusch as a new member to the Community Center Committee for a two year appointment. Other appointments are Historical Commission, Alderperson Jeff Dworak as Council Representative, renew the appointment of Addi Bernard to a one year term, Bonnie Schuller to a three year term and appoint Jim Brewster to a two year term, Pattie Walecka, Ben Gerold and Jenii Ratcliffe to a one year term. Board of Zoning Appeals reappoint Mark Stangel and Mike Bories to a two year term. The Lighthouse Preservation Committee appoint Alderperson David Kuehl as the Council Representative.

Mayor Christman also would like to appoint Elizabeth Rohr and Chelsea Dax, students of Kewaunee High School to the Park & Recreation Committee. Alderperson asked to have the appointments to the Park and Recreation table until the next meeting so clarification can be gathered on an age limit requirement for Committees.

Alderson Schiller moved, seconded by Alderson Kuehl to approve Mayor Christman appointment with the exception of tabling the Park & Recreation Commission to the next Council meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Establish Regular Meeting Dates for Council and Committee of the Whole

Alderson Griffith moved, seconded by Alderson Zimmerman to table and forward to the Committee of the Whole for discussion. Motion carried unanimously.

Designation of Green Bay Press-Gazette as Official Newspaper

Alderson Griffith moved, seconded by Alderson Kuehl seconded the motion to approve the Green Bay Press-Gazette as the Cities Official Newspaper. Motion carried unanimously.

Designation of Official Depositories - Bank of Luxemburg, Nicolet National Bank, Local Government Investment Pool (LGIP)

Alderson Jason moved, seconded by Alderson Schiller to approve the Bank of Luxemburg, Nicolet National Bank and Local Government Investment Pool as the Cities Official Depositories. Motion carried unanimously.
