

**OFFICIAL MINUTES
OF THE
CITY OF KEWAUNEE COMMON COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
AUGUST 29, 2016**

Mayor Christman called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Schiller moved and Kuehl seconded to approve Resolution 1051-16, Resolution for Exceeding the State Imposed Levy Limit. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously.

Dworak moved and Jelinek seconded to approve the wording of the referendum question to go on the November 8, 2016 ballot. Upon a roll call vote, motion carried unanimously. The question will read:

Under state law, the increase in the levy of the City of Kewaunee for the tax to be imposed on the 2016 tax bill, to be collected in fiscal year 2017, is limited to 0.78 percent, which results in a levy of \$1,103,480. Shall the City of Kewaunee be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the 2016 tax bill, to be collected in fiscal year 2017, by a total of 16.76 percent (\$175,000), which results in a levy of \$1,278,480? *(The common council intends that the levy increase be applied on an ongoing basis by including it in the base used to calculate the limit for 2017 as well as all subsequent years.)*

Jirtle moved and Zimmerman seconded to adjourn the meeting at 4:35 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
