RESOLUTION AND NOTICE OF SPECIAL CHARGES

RESOLVED, BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEWAUNEE, Kewaunee County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted on proper notice with a quorum and roll call vote of a majority of the Common Council present and voting resolves and orders as follows:

A special charge upon the Estate of Carolyn M. Massey, owner of a residence parcel located at 511 Dodge Street in the City of Kewaunee, for the following services is made under s. 66.0627, Wis. Stats.:

Demolition Charges and demolition permit totaling \$10,200 paid by the City of Kewaunee.

Charges and costs incurred by the City of Kewaunee for the above described special services shall be fully reimbursed and paid by such owner or its representative, to the City of Kewaunee, within ten (10) days after adoption of this resolution. These special services are and have been provided by the City of Kewaunee or its agents on the real property legally described as follows:

The South Quarter (S ¼) of Lot One (1), and the North 10 feet of Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12), Block One Hundred Seventy-Four (174), in the City of Kewaunee, Kewaunee County, Wisconsin.

If unpaid, the full amount of the special charges will be included in the current or next tax roll for collection and settlement by the City of Kewaunee under ch. 74, Wis. stats.

No public hearing and notice of public hearing was required regarding this special charge.

The City Clerk shall serve this resolution upon the landowners affected by regular first class mail, as the City's notice to the landowners under s. 66.0627 (3) (a), Wis. stats.

The City Clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
