Kewaunee Economic Development Corporation Announces: EnergySolutions to Host Job Fair For Decommissioning of the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Station

Kewaunee, Wis. (September 14, 2021) – The Kewaunee County Economic Development Corporation (KCEDC) shares the announcement that EnergySolutions and its subsidiary KewauneeSolutions will be hosting 2 job fairs this week targeting individuals and businesses interested in participating in the decommissioning process of the Kewaunee Nuclear Power Station.

EnergySolutions acquisition of the Kewaunee Power Station has expedited the decommissioning process from a 50 year timetable to 7-10 years. The decommissioning activities are scheduled to begin in 2022, ensuring a safe, efficient, and quicker clean-up of the Kewaunee Power Station.

KCEDC Executive Director Ben Nelson says “Hosting these two job fairs is an exciting kickoff to the decommissioning process and EnergySolutions commitment to local workers and businesses will provide a positive economic impact to the township of Carlton as well as Kewaunee County by creating jobs within the local community and provide some great opportunities for local vendors and subcontractors.”

The annual economic impact during the decommissioning project is expected to be approximately \$85M.
