**AUTHORIZING RESOLUTION TO COMMIT MATCH FUNDS FOR THE EDA PUBLIC  
WORKS AND ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TOWARD BUSINESS  
PARK DEVELOPMENT**

**RELATING** to the City of Kewaunee participation in the EDA Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Programs;

**WHEREAS**, federal monies are available under the Economic Development Administration (EDA) Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Program, in order to provide investments that support construction, non-construction, technical assistance, and revolving loan fund projects;

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council of the City of Kewaunee has authorized the submission of a Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Application to the EDA for the following project: The City of Kewaunee Business Park Development; and

**WHEREAS**, the Business Park Development Plan has been adopted into the municipal code under ordinance 546-07;

**WHEREAS**, we have carefully reviewed the estimated project costs (estimated project cost \$3,512,575.51), funding sources, physical location, and alternatives to the proposed project(s); and

**WHEREAS**, the total local matching funds required for projects indicated as being funded through the EDA Public Works and Economic Adjustment Assistance Program for communities meeting special need criteria as Nuclear Closure Communities is 20%; and

**WHEREAS**, The City Mayor is hereby authorized to be the representative for the EDA project and will sign all necessary documents on behalf of the City of Kewaunee.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Kewaunee does hereby authorize the commitment of match funds to be used as outlined in the EDA application, for the match amount of \$ 702,515.10 (20% match), from the following pending or potential source(s): In-kind contribution, the City's General Fund, and/or through the Boards of Commissions Public Lands Loan. The local match is available, committed to the project, and not encumbered in any way that may preclude its use, consistent with the requirements of EDA investment.
