**NEW BUSINESS**

**Review Highlights of Draft 2022 Budget**

Mayor Jelinek asked if there was anything Council wanted to bring up for discussion.

Clerk/Treasurer Decur stated the proposed budget has the changes Council made at the last workshop and the Tax Increment amount has been updated.

Discussion was held regarding the Public Works Director Position, regarding applications received and hiring process.

**Review Proposed Property Tax Levy**

Clerk/Treasurer Decur stated that the updated proposed 2021 Tax Levy, received by Council tonight is in the amount of \$1,691,293 which is a .7% increase. The County increase is estimated at a .6% increase and both School District have decreased.

Discussion was held on why the Tax Levy was changed. The Tax Levy was updated after the Tax Increment Worksheet was completed.
