

**OFFICIAL MINUTES  
OF THE  
CITY OF KEWAUNEE SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL  
MARCH 15, 2021 – 6:00pm - Virtual**

**APPROVAL OF DOCK REPAIRS – AUGIE KINJERSKI**

Marina Manager Kinjerski reviewed the situation with the docks and the amount of repairs that was needed. He also explained that most of the docks are being held together by chains. Port-A-Pier who normally did our dock repair is no longer in business and of the three other companies that were contacted, only one is available to do the repairs. Pier & Waterfront Solutions, LLC out of Sturgeon Bay quoted \$22,157 to do the repairs, but will need to do it soon as they have other client commitments. Marina Manager Kinjerski stated that Harv's Electric would be able to do the electrical repairs for time and materials. The amount of damage to the electrical at this time is unknown until the docks are fixed.

Aldersperson Vollenweider stated that he thought the docks had quick disconnects for the electrical and asked if a dollar amount limit should be placed on the repairs.

Marine Manager Kinjerski stated that the electrical issue is not at the start of the dock but at the fingers.

*Aldersperson Kuehl moved, seconded by Aldersperson Dworak, to approve to hire Pier & Waterfront Solutions, LLC, to repair the damaged dock and Harv's Electric to repair the Electrical damages as presented. Upon a roll call, Alderspersons Dworak, Brewster, Schiller, Vollenweider, Stangel, Kuehl and Zimmerman – aye, Aldersperson Mills – nay, motion carried.*
