

2022 ELECTION NOTICE

2022 Election season is quickly approaching. December 1, 2021 is the first day for candidates to circulate nomination papers. Packets of paperwork are put together for anyone who decides to run and are available at City Hall. Candidacy paperwork and nomination papers are due back by January 4, 2022 at 4:30 PM. Any incumbents not seeking re-election are required to file a notification of non-candidacy no later than Friday, December 24, 2021.

This year the following individuals will need to seek re-election if they wish to continue in their position:

Mayor – Jason Jelinek

1st Aldermanic District – Jeffrey Vollenweider

2nd Aldermanic District – James Brewster

3rd Aldermanic District – Janita Zimmerman

4th Aldermanic District – Dan Stangel

Aldersperson candidates require 20 signatures. Mayoral candidates require 50 signatures. It is suggested that candidates have a few more signatures than the minimum required number as some signatures may be found to be invalid. Once the nominations papers are submitted, the City Clerk will cross reference signatures with any other nomination papers turned in for the same office and if there are duplicates only the set of papers that the individual signed first will count. The City Clerk will also eliminate any signatures by residents that don't reside within your district.

Important dates leading up to the election:

12/1/2021 – First day for candidates to circulate nomination papers for the 2020 Spring Election

12/24/2021 – Deadline for incumbents not seeking re-election to file Notification of Non-candidacy

1/4/2021 – Deadline for candidates to file nominations papers, declarations of candidacy, and campaign registration statement

2/15/2022 – Spring Primary

4/5/2022 – Spring Election
